One of the ways the University Library supports learning and teaching is by facilitating the Digital Learning Environment. The Digital Learning Environment is available for all students and staff with a Maastricht University account.

The Digital Learning Environment for students consists of:

- Student Portal with integrated access to
 - TimetableExam registration and grades
 - Courses and organisations
 - Webmail
- Student Desktop (Anywhere)
- Video Service

- Learning Management System (EleUM)
- Video Services
- Digital Tools

Learning Management System

Our Learning Management System, called EleUM, is integrated in the Student Portal and offers students content for Courses and Tutorial Groups. Next to this, EleUM facilitates testing, handing in papers, originality checks on papers, discussion boards etc.

EleUM also allows teaching staff the opportunity to setup a web conference session with one or a whole classroom of virtual students.

Student Desktop

Student Desktop provides students with access to the computer resources needed during their studies. This includes common office software, but also reference software, statistical programs, modelling and programming languages (if a faculty or instructor requires them for students) and lots more.

Student Desktop Anywhere provides the same services on the students own, internet enabled, device everywhere in the world. Next to this, using Student Desktop Anywhere, a user is virtually

within the library and have access to all e-recourses you would have access to from the computers within the library.
